Dear Creditor:

As you know, this is, and has been for a number of years, a very difficult time in the commercial printing industry, especially for smaller independent operators. Unfortunately, Harmony Printing and Development Company ("Harmony") has not been immune from these challenges, and it is with sadness that we must report to you the upcoming closing and formal dissolution of Harmony. In closing, we advise you:

1. Harmony ceased operations on September 2, 2011 and the liquidation will proceed promptly.

2. Because Harmony's main lender possesses a security interest in all of Harmony's assets, the proceeds of any sale of Harmony's assets first must be applied to pay such lender in full. At this time, we are unsure what funds, if any, will be available to make payments to Harmony's unsecured creditors.


3. If you have a claim against Harmony, a letter describing such claim may be sent to Michael L. McCann, Spencer Fane Britt & Browne LLP, 1000 Walnut Street, Suite 1400, Kansas City, Missouri 64106. Each claim must include the following: the name, address, and telephone number of the claimant; amount of the claim; and the basis of the claim. Pursuant to Mo. Rev. Stat. § 351.478, any and all claims against Harmony will be barred unless such claims are received within 180 days from the above date of this written notice.

4. After payment of Harmony's secured lender and any other priority obligations, any remaining monies realized from the sale or other disposition of Harmony's assets shall be deposited into an account from which payments will be made on a pro-rata basis to Harmony's unsecured creditors.

We are doing what we believe in good faith is in the best interests of Harmony, and are willing to provide you with general information and periodic updates concerning Harmony's financial condition and status of the proposed closing. It is our sincere hope that we can complete the proposed transaction without the attendant higher costs for you and Harmony that would result were Harmony forced into bankruptcy. Thank you for your anticipated cooperation.
